Sharing in the Partnership

In December 1995, a group of Cullman citizens gathered to develop a long range plan for an educational foundation. A seed grant of \$20,000 was received from Alabama Power Company, and on May 9, 1996, the Cullman City Schools Foundation was born. During the first year the Foundation raised \$40,000 and awarded \$32,423 in grant money to city educators.

Since 1996, more than \$200,000 has been awarded to multiple city educators through various grants. Grants have included:

- playground equipment
- accelerated reading materials
- computer software
- science lab supplies
- multimedia equipment
- art program support



Our Purpose

The rich heritage of Cullman's schools reflect the values and ethics of generations of residents who have entrusted their most precious treasure, their children, to the city's public school system.

Keeping a keen eye on their mission, our educators prepare young people to be well-adjusted citizens who make positive contributions to a democratic society.

Cullman City Schools consistently rank in the top ten academically among Alabama schools. All five city schools are accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools. Our schools ranked 7th in the state in 2007 and 2008.

While we are proud of past accomplishments, we must always strive to reach higher standards. With your help, the Cullman City Schools Foundation will serve as a vehicle for achieving our goals.

Our Partnership

You can help to continue the Cullman City School System's tradition of excellence. The support you give provides academic experiences which are not otherwise funded with current available resources. All proceeds are spent on enhancing the classroom experience. The monies are awarded annually to teachers through a grant application process. Grants are approved by the Foundation's volunteer Board of Directors.

You can contribute in many ways. There are outright gifts of cash, securities, personal property, and real estate. There is also planned giving which might include trust arrangements, bequests in wills, and naming the Foundation beneficiary of a life insurance policy.

Levels of Giving
