## Schedule of the Week:

**Reading:** Nonfiction reading passages. We will answer comprehension and nonfiction text features questions about the passages. **(No tests this week in reading)**

**Phonics:** Words spelled with "ar"

**Heart words:** cold, or, sleep, now **(practice nightly)**

**English:** Contractions. **Test will be the following week. Review pages from class.**

**Math:** Fact fluency subtracting 8. Begin chapter 10. Adding 10 and 100 mentally using place value strategies, use an open number line to add 3-digit numbers, use models to add 3-digit numbers, use partial sums to add 3-digit numbers.

**Social Science:** Oceans and Continents. **I have attached a study guide for Thursday's test.** The test will have a number instead of the name of the ocean or continent. The students will identify each continent and ocean and match it to the corresponding number on the test. We have gone over this in class. If they study they should all do great.
