



2022 FALL SEMESTER EXAM SCHEDULE

Exam Schedule: December 15th, 16th, 19th and 20th

*Exam Exemption Policy Grade 12

Qualifying seniors will be eligible to exempt the semester exams for each class in which they earn an 80 in the course, no more than 1 unexcused absence, and no more than 2 discipline referrals.

*Exam Exemption Policy Grades 9-11

Qualifying underclassmen will be eligible to exempt one semester exam per the following guidelines.

Earn a minimum semester average of 90% in the course with 2 unexcused absences in the class and no more than 2 discipline referrals.

Earn a minimum semester average of 80% in the course with 1 unexcused absence in the class and no more than 2 discipline referrals.

Earn a minimum semester average of 70% in the course with 0 unexcused absence in the class and no more than 2 discipline referrals

Semester Exam Guidance

1. December 13-14th 2022
 - a. Teachers will review semester exams with students
 - b. New material may not be presented after December 12, 2022
 - c. Tests may not be administered on review days
 - d. Tests **must** be given according to the schedule above
2. Exceptions to schedule must be pre-approved by Mrs. Bates. (Emergency Circumstances Only)
3. Students not present for an exam must have Mrs. Bates approval to schedule a make-up exam.
4. Exams will count 20% of the final semester grade.

5. Students may not enter an exam more than 10 minutes late.
6. Students may not check out during an exam period.
7. Students may check out early on exam days using the following process:
 - a. Present a legitimate parent note at the end of the class period
 - b. Supervising faculty member will initial parent note and attach to *Early Check Out Register*
 - c. Student will record their signature and check out time on the *Early Check Out Register*
 - d. Supervising faculty will turn in *Early Check Out Register* at the end of each day
8. Students must not visit other schools while they are in session.
